Conference Overview

This 5th annual educational summit is presented by The Unforgettables Foundation and supported by California State University San Bernardino, Palm Desert Campus. Each conference intends to save lives by educating parents, caregivers, counselors, teachers, and students on how to recognize and overcome social, biological and environmental conditions that can be devastating to children and families in crisis.

Keynote speaker Dr. Anthony Silard's topic is "**Emotionally Intelligent Parenting in the Digital Age.**" Attendees will receive a copy of Dr. Silard's book, *Full Alignment: A Practical Guide to Transforming Your Life Vision into Action*. County District Attorney Mike Hestrin will address "**Parenting in the Age of Child Abuse and Child Endangerment,**" along with an update on local area high profile child abuse and endangerment cases.

Panelists will explore early childhood factors that strongly affect parenting of kids aged 0-5. As children progress through elementary and middle school, a myriad of social problems like racial and cross-cultural assimilation, bullying, violence, drugs and alcohol, as well as mental health issues, challenge parents and authority figures.

To help understand and overcome such community problems and deficient parenting styles, experts from the nonprofit agency Olive Crest will discuss successful remedial activities here in our local communities.
